Description of proposed project: Our project is to build a sheltered outdoor space, such as a gazebo, that will be usable in many ways. It will be used as a place to play during recess, being large enough for multiple groups of students to use it without being crammed in. It will be used as a gathering area for outdoor classroom time. It will have bench seating in the corners, providing a place to sit and also a large open area. It is an important project for the school because there is no real shade in the school yard and we need a place for students to be out of the hot sun or slight rain.

This project was the vision of one of our parents, Dennis Wubs, who passed away last December, after living with cancer for 10 years. He was 31 years old when he died. He was husband of Jennifer and father of 3 children who attend Timothy Christian School. We wish to honour the legacy of Dennis Wubs by building this shelter.
